

INTRODUCING MOSAICS OF REGIONAL AGING (MORA)

Senex: Journal of Aging Studies is an international double-blind peer-reviewed open access journal that seeks to advance dialogue among academics, researchers, decision makers and others concerned with aging studies.

In forthcoming issues of Senex: Journal of Aging Studies, we will introduce a new platform in our journal, entitled Mosaics of Regional Aging (MoRA). In MoRA, the focus will not be solely on any one country or society, but on a region. The author(s) will discuss the aging experiences of a region in terms of the historical context of the countries or societies therein, addressing not only the demographic transition processes of a single country, but comparisons between the experiences of the countries grouped within a given region. Author(s) should address the main demographic trends and the repercussions of the aging processes, highlighting the differences and similarities between the countries or societies living in an area, in terms of gender, ethnicity, and social classes. In this way, we recognize that aging does not suddenly appear in a particular country or society, but evolves within particular contexts. We aim to understand the aging experience through a comparative social and historical context in a given region. For example, we hope to better understand what inequalities exist between countries or societies and why they exist. The main challenges and advantages of comparative regional aging experiences should be identified, so as to expand and refine the current knowledge of scientists and researchers and in the hope that social policy makers will take heed and implement changes that generate improved outputs for society. MoRA will serve as a resource for updating and expanding our knowledge of aging in higher education, research and social policy globally.
